Panathlon Challenge benefited 62,981 young people with disabilities and SEN last year throughout England and Wales and recently in a new venture, Northern Ireland for the first time. We will in the year ahead 24/25 deliver nearly a thousand Mini-Paralympic type competitions across the country.
